The Nunavut Water Board (NWB or Board) received from Baffinland Iron Mines Corporation (Baffinland or Licensee) on July 15, 2022 the document entitled "Camp Lake Area Water Management Design Brief and Issued for Construction Drawings" dated July 5, 2022 (Design Brief) with a accompanying correspondence as the requirement of Part D, Item 2 of Water Licence No: 2AM-MRY1325 (Licence) that was originally approved by the Minister of Aboriginal Affairs and Northern Development on December 12, 2013.
