This submission provides the as-built drawings (Attachment 1) for the Crusher Pad Expansion completed at the Mary River Project Mine Site, in accordance with the reporting requirements outlined Part G, Item 4 of Baffinland Iron Mines Corporation's (Baffinland) Type A Water Licence – 2AM-MRY1325 Amendment 1 (Type A Water Licence). This submission was prepared in support of Water Licence Modification No. 1 approved under Motion No. 2017-A1-007.

This submission is also provided to address concerns raised by Crown Indigenous Relations and Northern Affairs Canada (CIRNAC) regarding the expansion of the Crusher Pad Sedimentation Pond. The attached as built confirms that the footprint of the Crusher Pad is less than the 107,500 m<sup>2</sup> catchment area on which the expanded pond design is based.
