Re: Follow-up to Spill 14-188 Reported on May 12th, 2014 Mary River Project - Water Licence No. 2AM-MRY1325

Summary:

At approximately 8:00 AM on May 12, 2014 it was discovered that raw sewage had pooled between two wings of the accommodations complex at the Mary River Mine Site. Upon investigation it was discovered that a joint on the lift station pump line had separated. A conservative estimate of approximately 2 m³ was released to the adjacent land surface, with an approximate impact area of 15 m².

Immediate and Follow-Up Action:

Personnel immediately took the sewage line out of service for repairs and notified the Environment and Maintenance Department. A vac truck was used to clean up the spill wherever possible. Cleanup of the sewage under the building is not possible at the present time due to the inaccessibility of the location. The spill poses no immediate environmental or health risk. The distance to the closest water body is >75M.

Recommendations:

Sewage lines throughout the accommodations complex will continue to be routinely inspected to prevent similar incidents from occurring in the future. The spill site will be reassessed after the snow melts and agricultural lime will be applied on the impacted area to control odour, if necessary.

Current Status:

The sewage line is repaired and back in service.
