Re: Receipt of Technical Review Comment Submissions for the NIRB's Review and NWB Consideration of Agnico Eagle Mines Ltd.'s "Whale Tail Pit" Project Proposal and associated Water Licence Application

Dear Ryan Vanengen:

On November 25, 2016 the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB) and Nunavut Water Board (NWB) jointly accepted the Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) and the information pertaining to the Type "A" Water Licence Application (the Application) submitted by Agnico Eagle Mines Ltd.'s (Agnico Eagle or Proponent) for the "Whale Tail Pit" Project Proposal (the Project) and initiated the public technical review process.

On January 27, 2017 the NIRB requested that responsible authorities, interested parties and those with specialist advice provide their technical review comments to the NIRB prior to the conclusion of the public comment period. In addition, the NWB reviewed the Application, determined the Application to be complete and gave Notice of the Application and invited interested persons to provide technical review comments in relation to the Application to the NWB directly. In the joint correspondence, interested parties were invited to submit their technical review comments in respect of the EIS to the NIRB and in respect of the Application to the NWB by no later than Tuesday, March 28, 2017.

As previously indicated, the NIRB and the NWB would like to offer Agnico Eagle an opportunity to provide an overview response to the technical review comments to facilitate the discussions at the upcoming Technical Meeting in Baker Lake (*April 28 – April 29, 2017*) and requests that the response be provided to the NIRB by **April 7, 2017**. Should Agnico Eagle require additional time to formulate its response to parties' comments, the NIRB and NWB request that it advise our offices of its anticipated timeline for a response as soon as practicable, keeping in mind the NIRB and the NWB's previous request that any response be provided at least 10 days' prior to the commencement of the Technical Meeting.

Agnico Eagle's response should briefly outline its understanding of the main issues raised in the technical comments and its proposed plans to address and resolve these issues and related concerns through its upcoming submission, including a draft list of commitments if possible. The draft list of commitments should also include an indication of Agnico Eagle's plans to satisfy any Information Requests directed to Agnico Eagle where a response was deferred to a later stage in the Review process (technical review, technical meeting), development of the submission following the Pre-Hearing Conference, or during the licensing/permitting/authorization application phase. The NIRB and the NWB will consider providing time at the beginning of the Technical Meeting for Agnico Eagle to present its response to parties, which should be intended to focus the following discussion on the most

appropriate items. The Boards asks that Agnico Eagle be prepared to provide sufficient printed copies of any related presentation materials for parties in attendance at the meeting.

The NIRB and the NWB would like to remind Agnico Eagle that all response(s) to the technical comment submissions on the Whale Tail Pit project proposal and on the Type "A" Water Licence Application should be <u>submitted to each Board independently</u>. Submissions to the NIRB should be provided directly to <u>info@nirb.ca</u> or through the online public registry at <u>www.nirb.ca</u>. Submissions to the NWB should be provided directly to <u>licensing@nwb-oen.ca</u>. All submissions are to be provided to the NIRB and the NWB by **April 7, 2017.**

April 19, 2017	 Parties submit comments to the NIRB and the NWB regarding the <i>Draft</i> Technical Meeting Agenda, including requests for additional time for presentation of issues Indicate whether French interpretation and/or special audio-visual equipment will be required at the Hearing (indicate which audio-visual equipment will be required). Requests for access from media outlets to record Hearing proceedings (film, photograph, audio).
April 21, 2017	1) Parties' presentations (English, Inuktitut, and French, if possible) provided electronically to the NIRB and the NWB and confirmation of attendance.
April 24, 2017	1) The Boards release Final Technical Meeting Agenda
