Re: Transport Canada's Participation in NIRB: 16MN056 Agnico Eagle Mines Limited - Whale Tail Pit Project Final Hearing

Transport Canada (TC) has reviewed the Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) and supporting documentation, participated through written submissions, and attended technical meetings and prehearing conferences in the Nunavut Impact Review Board's review of Agnico Eagle Mines Ltd.'s (AEM) proposed Whale Tail Pit Project to obtain additional information about project components within its mandate.

Following our analysis TC has determined that Mammoth and Whale Tail Lakes are not navigable for the purposes of the *Navigation Protection Act* (NPA). As the lakes are not navigable, Section 23 will not apply and AEM will not have to seek an exemption from the Governor in Council. AEM has indicated that they will not "Opt-In" for their project related inwater works on non-Scheduled waterways to be reviewed under the NPA and TC will not be issuing any approvals or permits for the proposed Whale Tail Pit Project. As we have no regulatory authority for the project, TC is no longer a Responsible Minister for the Whale Tail Pit project.

Although marine safety and security is not within the scope of the project proposal, TC recognizes that this is an important concern for Nunavummiut and will be available to respond to any questions regarding marine safety and security at the final hearing should a teleconference line be made available.
