On January 10, 2019 the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB or Board) accepted Agnico Eagle Mines Limited's (Agnico Eagle or Proponent) Final Environmental Impact Statement Addendum (FEIS Addendum) for the "Whale Tail Pit Expansion" proposal and commenced a technical review of the submission.
