Apologies for the delay in responding to AEM regarding the updates to the Groundwater Monitoring Plan v2.1, as it relates to the NIRB Project Certificate No 15.

After review of the new information provided in the Groundwater Monitoring Plan v2.1, I conclude that the overall objective of Term and Condition No. 15 has been met currently.

However, it should be noted that the fulfillment of Term and Condition No. 15 is subject to any "additional direction and requirements of the Nunavut Water Board." This essentially links the Environmental Assessment and the more detailed requirements of the water licensing processes, and we will be monitoring this to ensure AEM remains in compliance as this moves forward.
