#### Dear Alexandra Ozaruk:

The Nunavut Water Board (NWB or Board) has completed the technical review of the 2024 Annual Reports for the type A Water Licences: 2AM-MEA1530 and 2AM-WTP1830 (Meadowbank Licence, Whale Tail Pit Licence, or Licences). The Reports were received on March 31, 2025 from Agnico Eagle Mines Limited (Agnico Eagle or Licensee), submitted as a requirement under Part B of the Licences.

On April 17, 2025, the NWB acknowledged receipt of the Annual Reports and provided them to the Meadowbank distribution list for public review. Submissions were received from Crown-Indigenous Relations and Northern Affairs Canada (CIRNAC), Fisheries and Oceans Canada (DFO), and Kivalliq Inuit Association (KivIA) on or before July 25, 2025. Environment and Climate Change Canada (ECCC) advised that they were not able to review the 2024 Annual Reports and will not be submitting comments.

Agnico Eagle provided response to comments on August 29, 2025. DFO advised that they have reviewed Agnico Eagle's response and confirmed their comments have been addressed. On October 6, 2025, CIRNAC submitted their reply to Agnico Eagle's Response on their comments.

# **Summary of Review**

## Kivalliq Inuit Association (KivIA)

KivIA provided a comment regarding potential changes to the design of the Tailings Storage Facility originally documented in Project Certificate 004 in light of changes to impacts of climate variability and mine operations. KivIA recommended that the 2 m cover required in the Project Certificate be incorporated into any amended TSF design; these discussions to be continued and that any changes to the TSF design to incorporate KivIA feedback and address KivIA concerns; and any alterations to the TSF design be supported by adequate monitoring data. Agnico Eagle confirmed that ongoing discussions on the TSF cover will continue and will include details on monitoring.

# Fisheries and Oceans Canada (DFO)

DFO provided recommendations related to culverts, Marine Mammal Monitoring Program, aquatic invasive species, and underwater noise. DFO, in their follow up after reviewing Agnico Eagle's response noted that their comments have been addressed, and that they will further discuss the topic with the mine [Agnico Eagle] directly.

#### Crown-Indigenous Relations and Northern Affairs Canada (CIRNAC)

CIRNAC in their submission provided a number of comments and recommendations related to the following subjects:

- Closure Planning
- Approval of Major Project Changes and Revised Management Plans
- Water Quality Predictions of [Unapproved Activities]
- Model Prediction Accuracy and Decision Making
- Duration of Modelling Predictions
- Waterline to Vault
- Meromixis Stability in Vault Pit
- Revised Criterion for Total Dissolved Solids (TDS)
- Water Treatment of Reclaim Water
- Recontamination of Goose and Portage Pit Lakes
- Meadowbank TSF Cover Design
- Progressive Reclamation Documentation
- Groundwater Migration of TSF Reclaim Water

While the NWB appreciates the valuable comments form CIRNAC and the response from Agnico

Eagle, the NWB acknowledges that most of these comments are related to progressive and final reclamation. The NWB also notes that Agnico Eagle has been actively engaged with parties, including CIRNAC, regarding the Closure and Reclamation Plan (CRP), and that Agnico Eagle plans to submit the final CRP in near future. With the understanding that the final CRP when submitted will go through a detailed public review, the NWB is of the opinion that the comments related to closure and reclamation will be thoroughly discussed at that time. Meanwhile, the NWB encourages Agnico Eagle to consider CIRNAC's comments and recommendations while preparing the final CRP and also discuss outstanding matters within the relevant sections.

The NWB notes that Agnico Eagle submitted the following updated management plans with the 2024 Annual Reports:

All plans submitted for review will include a version control section, clearly stating the nature of changes in the plan, and identification within the document highlighting where changes have been made.
