Re: Whale Tail Dike Remediation, Water Licence 2AM-WT1830

Dear Richard and Jose,

The Kivalliq Inuit Association (KivIA) has reviewed Agnico Eagle's Whale letter regarding the Tail Tail Dike Remediation Work and also reviewed the 2018, Design Report of the Whale Tail Dike. The KivIA agrees that the work to construct an eastern abutment thermal berm should be allowed to proceed in order to stabilize the dike and re-establish permafrost in this section of the dike.

The Kivla requests that in addition to providing the "as-built drawings" within 90 days of the work completion that Agnico Eagle Mines Limited (AEM) also provide a brief memo outlining the following:

- The aggregate source(s) for the non-acid generating and non-metal leaching materials used to construct the thermal berm, and
- Results of the water quality monitoring for TSS during the work that should be compared to the limit established in Part D, Item 7 of water licence 2Am-Wt1830.

The KivIA has no additional comments at this time.
