M		<p><b>On August 24th, during an inspection of the Waste Rock Storage Facility (WRSF) dike, a water flow was observed at the toe of the dike at approximately 100m3/hr (to be confirmed). Flow was observed entering Mammoth Lake.</b></p> <p><b>Work was initiated to pump out the WRSF collection pond to decrease the water flow on August 24th. This is pumped towards Quarry 1. Work is being planned to establish access to the toe of the dike to develop a collection sump to pump the water towards Quarry 1. Water samples are being collected from the water flow and Mammoth Lake and will be sent to an accredited lab for RUSH analysis.</b></p> <p><b>An investigation is ongoing to determine the cause and an action plan is being created to stop the flow of water towards Mammoth Lake. A follow up report will be provided with further details.</b></p>
