Please find the following information as a follow up to the Spill report submitted November 27th, 2020 by Agnico Eagle Meadowbank division. This detailed report is submitted to the Inspector in compliance with the conditions under the Nunavut Water Board License 2AM-WTP1830, Part H, Item 8c.

Spill Description

During regular operations at the bottom of Whale Tail pit, the excavator operator noticed a hydraulic hose leak. He moved the machine and stopped the engine. Spill pads were used to contain as much of the spill as possible.



Spill location: 65'24'11.2" 96'42'03.2" on IOL

There were no off site impacts or discharge to any receiving watercourses. Distance to the closest water body is 600 meters to Mammoth Lake.

Cause of Spill

Equipment damage on excavator 12-0303.

Remediation Actions

The operator turned off the engine and contacted the mechanics to repair the system. Spill pads were used to contain the spill. Approximately 5m3 of contaminated material was collected to be disposed at the land farm in Meadowbank.



Corrective measures

A routine visual inspection of all systems is performed during pre-operations checks as a part of the preventative maintenance program.

Closure
