

### 2025-11-29 WTM 200L Hydraulic Oil

Please find the following information as a follow up to the Spill report submitted November 29<sup>th</sup>, 2025, by Agnico Eagle Meadowbank division. This detailed report is submitted to the Inspector in compliance with the conditions under the Nunavut Water Board License 2AM-WTP1830, Part H, Item 8c.

### **Spill Description**

During operations at Whale Tail Mine a hydraulic hose failed while a bolter was parked at the Underground Maintenance Shop Parking.



Spill Location: 65°24'21.39"N 96°40'45.38"W (on IOL)

The spill remained within the mine operations footprint. There were no off-site impacts or discharges. Distance to the closest water body is  $^{\circ}925m$  to Whale Tail South Lake.

# Cause of Spill

Mechanical Failure - wear and tear

#### **Remediation Actions**

The unit was stopped and absorbent material was placed to collect the spill. The contaminated absorbents were collected, segregated and disposed Hazmat area. ~1m3 of contaminated material was collected and brought to the Whale Tail Landfarm.



## **Corrective measures**

An extensive mechanical assessment of the unit was conducted. Routine visual inspections during pre-op checks and a thorough preventative maintenance done by maintenance department will continue as part of AEM's preventative maintenance program.
