Agnico Eagle Mines Limited has recently been informed by Crown Indigenous Relations and Northern Affairs Canada that the spill reporting process has changed in Nunavut.

The email submission process for spills is being replaced by an online webform, with the spills information still available through the GN/GNWT spill database.

As such, Meadowbank will be entering spills and related follow-up report through the new webform and we will no longer be sending spills information via email.

Our monthly and yearly reporting remains unchanged.
