4. DESCRIPTION OF UNDERTAKING (attach plans and drawings) This application is the renewal of existing water license NWB1BOS0106 which will enable the continuation of advanced exploration programs. The license renewal would cover continued water use and waste disposal at the Boston exploration camp.			
No significant change in the current exploration activity is envisioned at this site. The exploration activity at the Boston site will continue to include prospecting, continued surface diamond and reverse circulation exploration drilling, on-site core-splitting and logging, operation of a bulk sampling crushing and sorting plant, operation of an exploration accommodation camp including use of domestic water, treatment and disposal of greywater and sewage, fuel storage, operation of a hydrocarbon contaminated soil landfarm facility, on-site solid waste disposal in a landfill, collection of further environmental baseline data, and further underground development for exploration drilling and collection of bulk ore samples for metallurgical testing that may require handling of waste material and ore to be stored on surface on the existing waste / ore pads.			
MHBL is not proposing the construction of any new facilities or significant modification of the existing facilities under this application. This application is to cover renewal of the existing license under the existing conditions and requirements for a period of five additional years.
