**RE: 2BB-BOS1727 Notification of Discharge from BOS-3 Facility**

As per Part D, Item 23 of the Type B Water License 2BB-BOS1727, Agnico Eagle Mines Ltd. (Agnico) is providing written notification to the Inspector prior to the anticipated discharge of accumulated water from the BOS-3 containment facility located at the Hope Bay Project Boston Advanced Exploration site.

Water will only be discharged to the tundra upon receipt of analytical results that comply with the water quality criteria outlined within Part D of the water license. Effluent that does not meet the discharge criteria limits under Part D will be held for additional treatment or directed to the Doris-Madrid Tailings Impoundment Area.

Discharge volumes and analytical results will be provided in the monthly monitoring reports.
