**Re: Sewage Waste Incineration at Boston Camp under Licence 2BB-BOS1727**

Dear Mr. Shaikh,

As discussed on April 28, I am providing this letter to outline the short-term exploration work planned at the Boston site and the related Management Plan revisions.

The scope of work includes:

- Site preparation and maintenance from May 2 to May 21 by a small crew
- Full project occupancy from June 1 to August 31 with crews of approximately 10–20 personnel
- Planned activities include exploration work, portal maintenance and sampling, infrastructure clean-up, and general site maintenance

As this work is short term and most major infrastructure at the Boston camp will remain inactive, we are proposing an alternative procedure for managing sewage waste for the duration of this program.

Please find attached a revised *Incinerator and Compost Management Plan* and *Hazardous Waste Management Plan* for the Boston Project, applicable to Water Licence 2BB-BOS1727. Revisions have been made in Section 2 of the Incinerator and Compost Management Plan and Section D3 of the Hazardous Waste Management Plan. These revisions have been prepared to support the upcoming short-term exploration program at the Boston Project and to ensure that operational and waste management procedures are appropriately aligned with the scope and duration of the work, maintaining full compliance with Licence 2BB-BOS1727 requirements.

Agnico Eagle notes that both the *Incinerator and Compost Management Plan* and *Hazardous Waste Management Plan* were updated and submitted (January 2026) with the Operational Update - Water Licence Amendment Application. As the Boston exploration activities described above will take place before approval of the Water Licence Amendment, we have updated the most current approved version, while the January 2026 version remain “under review” through a separate process.
