Dear Mr. Curran

The Nunavut Water Board (NWB or Board) received from TMAC Resources Inc. (TMAC or Licensee) on September 14, 2020 an updated Interim Closure and Reclamation Plan for the Boston Advanced Exploration Project, for Board approval as required under Part I, Item 2, of Type B Water Licence 2BB-BOS1727. The Management Plan "presents the closure obligations and the plan for closing all facilities and demonstrates how the closure obligations will be met."

On September 15, 2020, the Plan was distributed for a one-month public review. On October 15, 2020, comments were received from the Kitikmeot Inuit Association (KIA), from Crown-Indigenous Relations and Northern Affairs (CIRNA), and NWB technical staff. On November 6, 2020, TMAC provided a response to these comments. By December 4, 2020, parties confirmed that all issues had been resolved.

In its submission, CIRNA requested clarification regarding operation and reclamation of drill sites, verification of reclamation activities, security verification and cost estimates for drill site and landfarm reclamation. In its submission, the KIA provided comments on the airstrip, use of non-potentially acid generating (NPAG) waste rock for ground cover, the pollution control pond and sedimentation pond, metal leaching (ML) materials, and reclamation of the vent raise. The NWB requested clarification regarding the reclamation of drill sites, sedimentation ponds, and the underground portal.
