Re: March 2013 – Monthly Monitoring Report for Water License 2BB-BOS1217

Boston Camp was shut down in November 2011 and has not been reopened since that time.

Winter site inspections are being conducted monthly while Doris Camp is seasonally closed and the ice between the mainland and Victoria Island allows snowmobile transit. Doris Camp was re-opened on March 25th, 2013. A winter site inspection was conducted by the winter check crew prior to the opening of Doris camp, and the results are summarized below. The full inspection is also attached to this report to comply with AANDC's request to see them.

1. Part D Items 8 and 21 (also Part J Items 2 and 5): Containment Pond, Bulk Fuel Containment, and Land farm

Water was not discharged from BOS-6 (land farm), BOS-5 (bulk fuel containment) or BOS-2 (containment pond).

2. Part J Item 3 and 4: Sewage Treatment Plant Effluent

No samples were taken from monitoring station BOS-3 or BOS-4 as the Sewage Disposal Facility was not operational.

3. Part J: Item 5 and 6: Seepage monitoring

There was no seepage observed in this month.

4. Part J: Item 8 (Reference to Part F: Item 7): Under-Ice Drilling Sampling

Under-ice water quality samples were not collected.

5. Part J Item 11: Water Use Volumes

No water was used as the camp is temporarily closed.

6. Part J Item 12: Mine Water Discharge Volumes

Mine water was not pumped from underground during this period.

7. Part J Items 13 and 14: Sewage Treatment Effluent and Sewage Sludge

Effluent was not discharged at BOS-3 and no sludge was removed from the Sewage Disposal Facility.

Incident Reporting

There were no incidents reported during the month pertaining to this licence.

Winter Site Inspection

The Boston Site and was inspected on March 19, 2013.

No issues of concern were identified during the inspection. Snowmobile trails at site from the January & February inspections were observed. The full inspection report is attached.

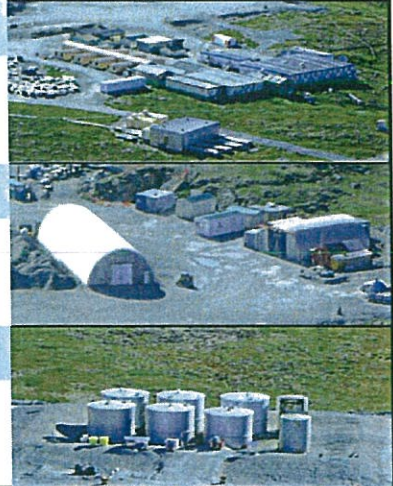
