Good Afternoon

I am contacting you today with respect to the Type B water license application for the Madrid Advanced Exploration Program, sent via email December 19 on our behalf by ERM Canada. In addition to the electronic version of the application attached to that email, there was an indication that hardcopies would be sent to your offices. I would like to confirm with you have received these hardcopies; if you have not received them, please let me know so that we can start tracking them with Canada Post.

The submission on December 19th, also indicated that the Inuktitut translated summary would be sent via email once available. I am pleased to provide that summary in the attached pdf document.

For your convenience the attached pdf document includes:

- Revised page I and ii, of the table of contents; and
- Revised pages (2-1 to 2-7) for all of section 2

We are forwarding hardcopies of these revised pages to your office and would recommend removing the current pages in the binder and inserting the new pages. Further, there was a CD included with the binder that included the complete application package broken into 5Mb files. I would suggest that when you ready to post the application to the ftp site, you contact ERM Canada (Elizabeth Sherlock, Elizabeth.Sherlock@erm.com) or me and the appropriate corrected electronic will be sent files to you.

As an update, TMAC personnel have arranged to meet with members of the Canadian Northern Economic Development Agency (CanNor) while we are both attending the Cordilleran Roundup Conference in Vancouver next week, the meeting is on Monday, January 26. TMAC staff are also travelling to Iqaluit on February 17 to meet with staff of various federal regulatory departments. CanNor is arranging the Iqaluit meeting so that TMAC can brief regulators on the attributes of the Hope Bay project and the applications we are bringing forward. TMAC would value the presence of personnel from the Nunavut Water Board at either or both of these meetings. If members of your staff will be available please let us know and we will provide details of the venue and time.
