Re: Commercial Lease KVCL303H305 - Request for Amendment

On December 5, 2007, Agnico-Eagle Mines Limited (AEM) submitted a letter with supporting documents requesting direction from the Kivalliq Inuit Association (KIA) on the required authorization for a new exploration camp at the Meadowbank Project. On your advice, received via email on February 13, 2008, AEM would like to formally submit a request for amendment to Commercial Lease KVCL303H305 to allow for the development of this new exploration camp. The camp is also subject to approval by the Nunavut Water Board (NWB), and a request for amendment of the current Type B Exploration Water License was submitted to the NWB on February 1, 2008.

The existing exploration camp is located in the center of the proposed Meadowbank mine site and has been overwhelmed by the proposed mine construction and development activity. The new exploration camp would be constructed near Third Portage Lake adjacent to Km 100 on the all weather private access road (AWPAR) between the Hamlet of Baker Lake and the Meadowbank site. The camp will be used to support ongoing mineral exploration efforts in the coming years.

Supporting documentation for this amendment request, sent to your office in December 2007, includes:

- A Project Description for the proposed exploration camp;
- A Preliminary Closure and Reclamation plan for the new exploration camp; and
- A Spill Contingency Plan for the proposed site activities.
