

An inspection of Agnico Eagle Mines Ltd.'s ('Licensee'), Meadowbank Advanced Exploration Project was completed by Crown-Indigenous Relations and Northern Affairs Canadas', Resource Management Officer, Christine Wilson ('Inspector'). The inspection was conducted to ensure compliance with applicable terms and conditions of water licence ('licence') no. 2BB-MEA1828. PRELIMINARY INFORMATION — March 26 th , 2020 Amendment no. 1 was approved to allow for the relocation of the Amaruq Exploration Camp from Whale Tail Mine Site to N65° 24′ 56″, W96° 37′ 48″. The camp has not yet been moved. — The 2021 annual report is available for review on the Nunavut Water Board ('Board') FTP website in accordance with Part B item 6. — The Licensee provided an update to the plan titled "Amaruq and GOT Exploration Projects Spill Contingency Plan" for Board approval within 30 days as required by Amendment no. 1, Part H item 1. — Six (6) drill sites were chosen at random from the information provided in the 2021 annual report. OBSERVATIONS 1. The following drills holes are inspected and noted to respect licence conditions found in Part F and Part I item 10 with regards to drilling and restoration of drill sites.

2. 100L of diesel was spilled to the ground in a rocky location at approximately N65° 6′ 12.78″, W96° 17′ 23.89″. Spill no. 21-388 was assigned to the file. No concerns noted relating to the spill or the remediation (photo 3). The file is recommended for closure-remediated. 


The vicinity of drill hole 7001-21-066 and surface water accumulation from recent rainfall.
