Hi Isabelle.

I realize that the water licence only requires analysis for specific parameters but AEM is still obligated to confirm that the effluent is not considered a waste. I noted that you did not sample for any other parameters often associated with sewage effluent. I will be taking this into consideration during my next inspection and recommend a suite of samples to be taken to confirm the quality of the effluent.

To commission the STP means to bring the unit into working order, not just meet the criteria in a water licence.

Ms. Wilson,

As per Water Licence 2BB-MEA1318 Part D Item 17, please consider this as the 10 days notice to advise you that we will be commencing the water pumping from the membrane bioreactor wastewater treatment system (Monitoring Station MEA-2) to the tundra.

An estimated total of 20 m³/day will be pumped. To avoid erosion, the water will be directed in a natural boulder field located near the Newterra system, where direct flow into a water body is not possible. The discharge will occur only if the water meet the discharge criteria in accordance with Part D, Item 14 of the NWB Water Licence. Samples have been collected and work is scheduled to begin once we received the analyses results, as long as the results meet the discharge criteria.
