Subject: Fuel Storage at WMC's West Meliadine Camp

Dear Jim,

As per our conversation today by phone I am writing this letter as confirmation of the status of fuel storage at the WMC West Meliadine camp site outside of Rankin Inlet.

In July of 2002 WMC 'winterised' the West Meliadine camp and drained all bulk storage tanks of diesel and Jet-A fuel; all camp 900 lt household tanks of diesel; and all 205 lt drums of diesel, Jet-B and junk fuel. All fuel was transported off site and sold, or put into secure storage in Rankin Inlet. In the same manner any and all gasoline and propane were transported off site and sold.

As of January 2003 the only fuel remaining at the site is one (1) 205 lt drum attached to a drip stove at the WMC safety trailer. This trailer is designated as an emergency shelter for anyone who may need it over the winter.

At this time WMC is attempting to sell its interest in the Meliadine project, and has no immediate plans to reopen the camp. The camp is in a condition for immediate start-up for any new owner to carry out work.

I hope this memo meets your requirements for reviewing the permit for WMC. Please contact me if you require any further information.
