Hi Phyllis,
Thank you for forwarding us the INAC review.

Our water license is coming due around the end of this year. To give you a heads-up on Comaplex's proposed plans - we will be applying for an extension of the water license, but in the reduced capacity of an exploration license (not a bulk sample; not BB), as our underground program is now complete. We realize we will need to continue to monitor the water and this will need to remain part of the license.

Also, in regards to the INAC directives, we will be applying for an amendment to exclude the water meter demand from the extended license (as per the Deputy Minister's response letter). It is our intention to get started on the paperwork for all of this in the near term. Cheers.
