Dear Ms. Beaulieu;

Agnico-Eagle Mines Limited (AEM) applied for the above noted amendment at the time it was also requesting an exception from the Nunavut Impact Review Board to build the Phase 1 All Weather Access Road (AWAR). The amendment application was a contingency in the event the NIRB did not grant AEM the exception.

On February 20 of this year, the NIRB did grant AEM an exception for the Phase 1 AWAR. Having the Phase 1 road will allow fuel to be trucked from Rankin Inlet to the Meliadine site. As a result, AEM will not need additional fuel storage constructed at the Meliadine site for its advanced exploration program and wishes to withdraw its amendment #4 application.
