English Summary

In 2015, the number of people working at the Meliadine camp will vary from 120 to 250 persons. All the wastewater from the kitchen, toilets, showers, washing machines, cleaning and so on needs to be treated before it can be released to the environment.

Agnico Eagle is proposing to add BIONEST systems to enhance wastewater treatment at the Meliadine camp. The BIONEST systems will receive the flow from the Biodisk wastewater treatment plants and further improve its quality before the water is released to the environment.

Agnico Eagle records how much water it uses each day and reported the totals to the Nunavut Water Board and the Kivalliq Inuit Association in its monthly and annual reports. Agnico Eagle is requesting that the total water that can be used for all purposes be increased from 290 cubic metres per day to 299 cubic metres per day. The water will largely be used in the camp, drilling for gold deposits, and extending the underground decline longer and deeper.
