Dear John Witteman:

On February 17, 2011 the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB or Board) received an application from Indian and Northern Affairs Canada (INAC) for an extension to Agnico-Eagle Mines Ltd.'s (AEM) "CWM Claim Group-Mining Exploration" Land Use Permit (LUP) N2007C0041.

The NIRB has reviewed the information provided and finds that the extension request does *not* contain sufficient information for the NIRB to permit proper screening. Specifically, the NIRB is requesting submission of the following information by **March 9, 2011**.

- *Summary report of activities undertaken to date as permitted by LUP N2007C0041 as per the Screening Decision issued March 27, 2008*
- *Specific coordinates for work to support the extension request*
- *Non-technical summary of activities proposed under extended LUP N2007C0041 as compared to original INAC LUP application dated October 29, 2007 in English and Inuktitut*
- *Maps (maps should show all project components relative to the CWM Claim Group – i.e. water bodies, camps, access routes/winter trails, fuel caches, airstrips, etc)*
