Comaplex Mineral Corporation Application to Amend Water License 2BB-MEL0709

Dear Phyllis

The Kivalliq Inuit Association (KIA) has reviewed the application by Comaplex Minerals Corporation (CMC) to amend water license 2BB-MEL0709 and is pleased to provide the following comments.

CMC mentions that the bermed fuel storage area will be constructed of crushed esker, till and waste rock material. If waste rock is to be used for construction purposes, KIA requests additional rock quality information is collected. CMC must provide ARD and metal leaching potential analytical results for the specific waste rock horizon/zone proposed for constructing the bermed fuel storage area. Analytical testing should be conducted on stockpiled material in the waste rock storage area prior to transporting the rock to the construction site. Special emphasis should be placed on managing waste rock as the bermed fuel storage area drains towards a different watershed not identified within the Water Management Plan or the Waste Rock and Ore Storage Management Plan.
