Dear Mr. Dwyer:

At your request, the Department of Culture, Language Elders and Youth (CLEY), Government of Nunavut, has reviewed the above-noted application. Our recommendations are limited to CLEY's mandate and follow.

In 2008 Comaplex Minerals Corp. hired Golder and Associates to conduct an archaeological assessment of an proposed all weather road and related borrow locations. There is no mention of 2009 drill location and any areas of ground disturbance should be assessed for archaeological potential prior to the disturbance occurring. CLEY recommends at a minimum Comaplex Minerals Corp. hire an archaeological consultant to conduct a desk top Overview assessment, however a field assessment would be better.
