At your request, the Department of Culture, Language Elders and Youth (CLEY), Government of Nunavut, has reviewed the above-noted application. Our recommendations are limited to CLEY's mandate and follow.

We recommend the applicant retain the services of a professional consulting archaeologist with arctic experience to conduct an inventory of the yet unrecorded archaeological sites within the project area (there are 30 recorded archaeological sites) and mitigation of sites that are known to be in conflict with the development plans.

The attached is a list of consultants with experience working in Nunavut who may be contacted to conduct an Inventory and CLEY's Guidelines for Developers. Other professional archaeological consultants may also be hired.
