On June 8 th , 2018 an inspection was conducted of Agnico Eagle Mines' ('AEM'), spring drilling campaign, authorized under water licence no. 2BB-MEL1424. The inspection was completed by Indigenous and Northern Affairs Canada's Water Resource Officer, Christine Wilson and Atuat Shouldice with the assistances of the Government of Nunavut's Conversation Officer, Daniel Kaludjak. This report was produced with the findings of the inspection. Note: the inspection plan included an additional three location that were aborted. Observations 1. Drill hole M18-2464 is located approximately at N63° 00′ 06.4″, W92° 09′ 30.4, which is on Inuit owned land with surface and sub surface rights. The drill rig had recently moved to this location and begun drilling.						
 The drill site is located in between two small water bodies, with the actually drill approximately 60ft from a flowing stream (photo 1). The inspector is concerned that the proponent may have failed to meet the requirements of PART F item 1. The water intake is located on a lake proximal to the drill hole, approximately at N63° 00′ 12.3″, W92° 10′ 01.6″. The water intake is operated in accordance with PART C item 1, item 3 and item 5. The cuttings line is located on to the north east side of the drill rig. Though the location of the line appeared to be 31 meters from a water body, the cuttings water would have connectivity with the nearby lake because of freshet. This activity fails to meet the requirements of PART F item 2.

Closing Remarks -The inspector noted that this would be the second failure to comply related to drilling.
