RE: 2BB-MEL0914: Water Use Fees for 2009

Dear Ms. Beaulieu,

The calculation of water use fees for the Meliadine Gold Project was based on the NWT Waters Act:

Northwest Territories Waters Regulations Regulations Respecting Inland Water Resources in the Northwest Territories SOR/93-303

9. (1) Subject to subsections (4) and (5), the fee payable by a licensee for the right to the use of water, calculated on an annual basis, is

- (b) in respect of an industrial, mining and milling or miscellaneous undertaking, the greater of \$30 and the aggregate of
 - (i) for the first 2 000 m³ per day that is authorized by the licence, \$1 for each 100 m³ per day,
 - (ii) for any quantity greater than 2 000 m $^{\circ}$ per day but less than or equal to 4 000 m $^{\circ}$ per day that is authorized by the licence, \$1.50 for each 100 m $^{\circ}$ per day, and
 - (iii) for any quantity greater than 4 000 m $^{\circ}$ per day that is authorized by the licence, \$2 for each 100 m $^{\prime}$ per day; and

The quantity of water used by the Meliadine Gold Project did not exceed 163 m³/day.
