<u>Re:</u> Water Licence 2BB-MEL0709: Part G Conditions Applying to Modifications: Modification to Waste Disposal Facilities

Dear Mr. Kabloona;

In keeping with our water licence, Comaplex Minerals Corporation is notifying the Board of modifications to our waste disposal facilities. Presently, toilet waste is incinerated and greywater discharged to a wetlands area. This is now being modified.

A new Biodisk treatment plant is being installed at the camp to improve waste water treatment. The Biodisk treatment plant is a rotating biological contactor. The changes include low flush toilets and urinals in a wash car. This will discharge to the Biodisk treatment plant which is a separate unit.

The benefits of the modifications include energy savings in no longer incinerating toilet waste and extended treatment of greywater prior to discharge. The effluent from the Biodisk treatment plant will be discharged a wetlands area as outlined in other letter of July 22, 2009.

We trust this modification meets with the Board's approval.
