Dear Ms. Beaulieu:

The Government of Nunavut, Department of Environment (DOE) has reviewed the Fuel Management and Spill Contingency Plan for the Meliadine Bulk Sampling Project. The DOE has the following comments and recommendations based on the *Environmental Protection Act*.

- A Waste Manifest document must accompany all movements of hazardous materials, and all parties must register with the Environmental Protection Service at the GN-DOE. The general number for the Department of Environment is (867) 975-7700. This process and contact information should be stated in the Plan.
- To supplement the contents of the spill kits, shovels, pick-axes and extra drums should be available for use at all areas, should a spill occur.
- DOE recommends that a copy of the NWT-NU Spill Report Form be included in this plan.
