Background/History:

The Meliadine West gold project is an advanced exploration, bulk sampling project located 25 km west – northwest of Rankin Inlet in the Kivalliq Region of Nunavut. In 2008 the underground bulk sampling program was completed (no additional underground work scheduled for 2009); while in 2009 further surface drilling and exploration will continue.

Recommendations/Comments:

Fuel Management and Spill Contingency Plan

- All fuels including drums and bladders should be relocated to the lined designated area as it appears to provide adequate secondary containment.
