- 1. Part 3, Item 5, shall be amended to the following:
 - 5. The Permittee shall
 - i. ensure that during their summer drill program all drill cuttings and any retuyrn water and sludge that cannot be re-circulated be disposed of in a properly constructed sump or an appropriate natural depression that does not drain into a water body; and
 - ii. for their winter drill program collect drill cutting and store them in barrels for removal to Rankin Inlet Municipal Solid Waste Facility.

All other terms and conditions of the original approval dated March 1, 1999 remain unchanged.
