BIMC has discussed the need for a continuing Type B Water Licence and its intent to seek renewal and amendment of the Type B Water Licence with the QIA and all interested parties during the technical meetings and final hearings in Pond Inlet for Baffinland's Type A Water Licence. The QIA and other interested parties have not expressed any concerns to date. When the amended Type B Water Licence was issued on Dec. 4, 2013, the Board noted that the licence would need to be amended in short order.

The inspector concluded that, "Baffinland Iron Mines Corp was found to be working diligently on clearing snow and ramping up activities for the 2013 field season."
