In issuing this correction, the Nunavut Planning Commission took account of a number of considerations, including:

1. Authorization for the feasibility study and bulk sampling program is being applied for under the same INAC land use permit. This did not come to NPC's attention until December 15. The proponent's non-technical project summary for the feasibility study had indicated that "separate applications are being submitted" for the two sets of activity (page 2).
2. The two sets of activities are scheduled for overlapping timeframes; appear to involve some shared facilities; cover overlapping areas, and are proposed in support of the same projected mining project.

The complete conformity determination for this project proposal will address both the feasibility study and bulk sampling components of the project.
