Could you please provide the Board with the following information:

- 1. The scope (Section 2) of the Action Plan states that a containment area will be constructed for the new storage tank and supporting facilities. An explanation is required on what are considered as supporting facilities;
- 2. Results of geotechnical drilling undertaken in June 2011, aimed at confirming the integrity of the proposed tank location.
- Confirmation is required on whether the proposed containment dyke schedule for construction this summer (2011) would be confined to that immediately surrounding 5 M litre tank, as depicted in the drawing No. H 337697-4020-042-001. In other words, confirm if the extended containment area projected for future expansion of the fuel storage facility, as shown in the same drawing, will be constructed this summer as well.
- 2. Alternative method(s), other than land-farming, for the treatment and/or disposal of hydrocarbon contaminated soils affiliated with proposed decommissioning of the existing bulk fuel storage facility at Milne Inlet.
