The Board has not been in receipt of any comments from intervening parties pertaining to those reports. The NWB’s staff reviewed the documents and determined they are mostly consistent with the reporting requirements under Licence 2BB-MRY1114. The Board, however, notes that the SNP reports for February, March, and May 2011 indicate that oil and grease and/or faecal coliform analyses had not been conducted because of delays in shipping of samples for analyses, errors in sampling, the bottles containing samples being broken during transportation, or for other reasons

For due diligence purposes and to ensure that all required analyses are being conducted for the parameters in the Licence, the NWB recommends that the Licensee develop and implement appropriate contingency measures as part of its monitoring program. Further, the NWB recommends that in cases where a facility, such as a wastewater treatment plant, is producing effluent that does not meet the criteria in the Licence, the Licensee should include as part of the respective SNP reports an explanation of the measures implemented and/or contemplated to resolve the issue(s) associated with that facility.
