To whom it may concern;

A final compliance inspection was conducted of water licence no. 8BC-AEA1525 and 2BC-WTP1819 between August 28th and 30th 2018. These licences were issued to Agnico Eagle Mines Limited (AEM) for operation and construction of the Amaruq exploration road and Whale Tail Pit /Haul Road. The inspector determined that conditions of the two licences have been met and understands from correspondence with the Nunavut Water Board that the components of the predevelopment licences will be covered by the type 'A' water licence no. 2AM-WTP1826, issued May 29th 2018.

The inspector sees no reason to deny any application for the cancellation of licences 8BC-AEA1525 and 2BC-WTP1819 if requested by AEM.
