

Dear Ms. Granchinho and Ms Gillard,

Agnico Eagle thanks the Nunavut Impact Review Board ("NIRB") for the opportunity to respond to your email dated June 15, 2017, which requested clarification regarding the applicable NIRB process which Agnico Eagle anticipates would apply to our June 15, 2017 Type B Application. Following discussions with NIRB and Nunavut Water Board ("NWB") staff as well as internal review, Agnico Eagle intends to withdraw the June 15, 2017 Type B Predevelopment Application.

Agnico Eagle intends to consult with the Kivalliq Inuit Association ("KIA") and governmental reviewers over the coming weeks to evaluate whether it would be appropriate in the circumstances to proceed with an exception application in relation to the proposed predevelopment/site preparation work. Following its consultation with external reviewers regarding procedural matters and the proposed scope of work, should Agnico Eagle decide to proceed with an exception application, Agnico Eagle will be revising and re-submitting the Type B Application, and providing the NIRB with an application for exemption by July 14th, 2018.

On June 15, 2017 the NIRB was cc'd on six (6) emails from Agnico Eagle Mines Ltd.'s (Agnico Eagle) regarding a new Type 'B' Water licence application for the Nunavut Water Board (NWB). The new Type 'B' Water licence was being requested for proposed pre-development/site preparation work related to the Whale Tail Pit and Haul Road which is currently undergoing joint Review by the NIRB (File No. 16MN056) and NWB (File No. 2AM-WTP----). The same day, the NWB sent an email to Agnico Eagle and included the NIRB stating that it would not be processing the application until confirmation was received from the NIRB in accordance with Section 12.10.2 of the Agreement between the Inuit of the Nunavut Settlement Area and Her Majesty the Queen in right of Canada (Nunavut Agreement).

The NIRB would like to request confirmation from Agnico Eagle that the aforementioned application is a 12.10.2(b) exception application for the NIRB to consider excepting the proposed pre-development/site preparation activities at the Whale Tail Site from the NIRB's current Review of the Whale Tail Pit project proposal.
