Dear Jeff Ward:

Please be advised that Section 12.7.1 (b) of the Nunavut Land Claims Agreement (NLCA) states:

*“a recommendation of Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB) pursuant to a 12.4.4 (a) may provide for the establishment of a monitoring program for that project which may specify responsibilities for the proponent, NIRB or Government.”*

Further, Section 12.7.3 (a) of the NLCA states:

Without limiting the generality of Section 12.7.2, the monitoring program set up pursuant to that section may include:

*“a requirement that regulatory agencies and the proponent supply NIRB with reports and information respecting project operations and impacts, and the implementation of mitigative measures.”*

According to the terms and conditions contained in the NIRB’s Screening Decision Report on July 31, 2008, for the “Angilak” project proposal, Kivalliq Energy Corporation is to submit an Annual Report to the NIRB no later than January 31<sup>st</sup> of each year. At this time, the NIRB has not yet received Kivalliq Energy Corporation’s annual report for the “Angilak” for the 2013 reporting period.

Kivalliq Energy Corporation is advised to refer to the terms and conditions issued within the Screening Decision Report (attached) regarding the submission of your Annual Report. NIRB is requesting this information by **November 6, 2014**.
