The Nunavut Water Board (NWB or Board) has completed its review of the 2015 Annual Report (Report) submitted by Kivalliq Energy Corporation on February 16, 2016 for the Angilak Project, a uranium exploration project located approximately 225 kilometres southwest of Baker Lake, in the Kivalliq Region of Nunavut.

The review determined that the Report, which includes the following documents, is generally complete and consistent with the reporting requirements under Part B, Item 2, of Licence No. 2BE-ANG1318 and related amendment:
