This letter notifies NWB that Kivalliq Energy Corporation's 2012 field camp will be commencing drilling operations on or about March 30, 2012. There are presently two coring rigs, contracted from Major Drilling, and one reverse circulation (RC) drill, contracted from Northspan Explorations, on the property. A third coring rig will be mobilized to site for operations during the summer months. Approximately 26,000 metres of diamond drilling and 9,000 metres of RC drilling is contemplated by the 2012 program. Activities are expected to be completed by about October 15, 2012.
