COMMENCEMENT OF SUMMER FIELD OPERATIONS AT THE ANGILAK PROPERTY

This letter is to notify Crown-Indigenous Relations and Northern Affairs Canada ("CIRNAC"), the Nunavut Water Board ("NWB"), the Kivalliq Inuit Association ("KIA") and the Workers' Safety and Compensation Commission ("WSCC") that the summer mineral exploration activities will be commencing at the Angilak Property.

The summer program is anticipated to mobilized on June 26 and to be completed by mid-September. The summer program will comprise diamond drilling, mapping, prospecting and lake sediment sampling.

All operations will continue to adhere to the terms and conditions specified in CIRNAC Land Use Permit ("LUP") N2019C0013, NWB Water Licence 2BE-ANG2227 and KIA land use licence KVL308C09. All permits, licences, mineral exploration agreements and mineral tenure have been assigned/transferred to 5833 Nunavut Ltd., the new project operator.
