Hi Andrew:

As requested in the Nunavut Water Board's (NWB or Board) April 3, 2014 correspondence to Kivalliq Energy Corporation, the following information is required for your water licence amendment application to proceed to the next stage(s) of the licensing process:

- Anticipated number of drills to be used on site, and a complete break-down of the total volume of water being requested under the licence amendment. Block 13 of the amendment application, indicates that 98.2 cubic metres/day of water is required for each drill and 2.5 cubic metres/day for camp use. The total volume of water being requested under the licence is 300 cubic metres per day.
- 2. Confirmation, as provided by the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB), on whether the screening decision report dated March 22, 2012 would apply to the amendment currently being requested.
- 3. Confirmation, as provided by the Nunavut Planning Commission (NPC), on whether the conformity determination dated April 29, 2008, would apply to the amendment application that is currently before the Board.

Hello Sean,

In response to your questions (below), attached please find the NIRB screening decisions for Kivalliq Energy's 2014 NWB Amendment Application, which Kivalliq Energy received from Phyllis Beaulieu via e-mail on April 7, 2014. I have not heard back from the NPC yet.

With regard to the number of drills Kivalliq Energy plans to use on site, there would be a maximum of 3 drills turning on site at any one time. Block 13 of the amendment application should therefore indicate a maximum water use of 98.2 cubic metres/drill/day for a maximum of 3 drills per day, plus 2.5 cubic metres of water /day for camp use, for a total daily water use of 297.1 cubic meters/day.
