Re: Application Pending NPC Conformity for Kivalliq Energy Corporation's Angilak Project Proposal

Dear Craig Finnigan:

The Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB or Board) received Kivalliq Energy Corporation's Angilak Project Proposal from the Kivalliq Inuit Association (KIA) on March 27, 2008. The Project Proposal submission included the following documents:

- *KIA Application for Access to Inuit Owned Lands*
- *Non technical Project Proposal summary in English*

Your project appears to be located in an area which requires conformity to the Keewatin Regional Land Use Plan. Pursuant to Article 11 of the Nunavut Land Claims Agreement (NLCA), the project proposal must be sent to the Nunavut Planning Commission (NPC) for a conformity determination with this Plan. This can be done by contacting Brian Aglukark at NPC (phone: 867-857-2242 email: aglukark@npc.nunavut.ca).

Once a conformity determination is made, the NPC will forward its determination and recommendations to NIRB. At that time NIRB will carry out screening of the Project Proposal in accordance with Article 12 of the NLCA.

Additionally, NIRB has undertaken a preliminary completeness check and finds that your project proposal does **not** contain sufficient information for the NIRB to conduct an environmental screening. Specifically NIRB is requesting submission of the following information:

- *NIRB Part 1 Summary Application Form in English*
- *NIRB Part 1 Summary Application Form in Inuktitut*
- *Non technical Project Proposal summary in Inuktitut*
- *NIRB Part 2 Form - Project Specific Information Requirements (PSIR)*
- *Maps*
