Dear Jeff Ward:

On June 28, 2011 the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB or Board) received an application from Aboriginal Affairs and Northern Development Canada (AAND) for an extension to Land Use Permit N2008C0026 for Kivalliq Energy Corporation's "Angilak" project. All documents received pertaining to this project proposal include:

- *Kivalliq Energy Corporation's Extension Request Letter;*
- AAND Email to the NIRB regarding Kivalliq Energy Corporation's Extension Request.

Previously, on May 5, 2011 the NIRB requested submission of Kivalliq Energy Corporation's 2010 annual report for the above mentioned project. The response received from the proponent indicated that there had been a previous attempt to deliver the report via mail to the NIRB office and that another copy would be sent as a result of the inquiry. Upon receiving the current extension application, the NIRB undertook a preliminary completeness check and found that the proposal did *not* contain sufficient information to permit the NIRB to assess the scope of the request against the previously screened project activities; therefore on June 29, 2011 the NIRB again requested submission of the 2010 annual report. To date no further details have been received despite repeated inquiries from the NIRB regarding shipping details for the information.

The NIRB is requesting submission of the following information by August 1, 2011:

■ 2010 Annual Report which includes the 2011 work plan, due January 31st of each year, as outlined in the Screening Decision Report dated July 31, 2008.
