This letter notifies the NWB that construction of Kivalliq Energy Corporation's 2010 field camp is nearing completion and full operations should commence by April 23, 2010. We expect to start drilling shortly thereafter and initially work will be conducted with a single drill rig. A second drill rig will be mobilized to site during June. We expect to be drilling with 2 drill rigs during the months of July and August. Approximately 10,000 metres of drilling is planned. Activities are expected to be completed by September 30, 2010.
